

National Training Wage Summary

Wage Summary

EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2018

The Fair Work Commission released its minimum wage decision on 1 June 2018. The decision, effective from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2018 sees the modern award rates increased by 3.5%.

This increase flows on to junior employees, employees to whom training arrangements apply and employees with a disability.

Who does the wage summary apply to?

The attached wage summary applies to employers in the private sector throughout Australia who are covered by a modern award, and their employees who are undertaking a traineeship whose training package and Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) level is allocated a wage level by the National Training Wage provisions in various modern awards.

The National Training Wage applies only to trainees engaged in study for the qualifications listed; it does not apply to any other employees.

The qualifications to which the National Training Wage applies are split across several levels as follows:

Please note that businesses operating under workplace agreements (such as AWAs, ITEAs, certified agreements, or enterprise agreements) are also not bound by this wage summary. Instead, refer to the applicable workplace agreement and if required, call 1800 RETAIL (738 245) for assistance.

The NRA has calculated the figures in this wage summary by rounding to 2 decimal places throughout the calculation process.
