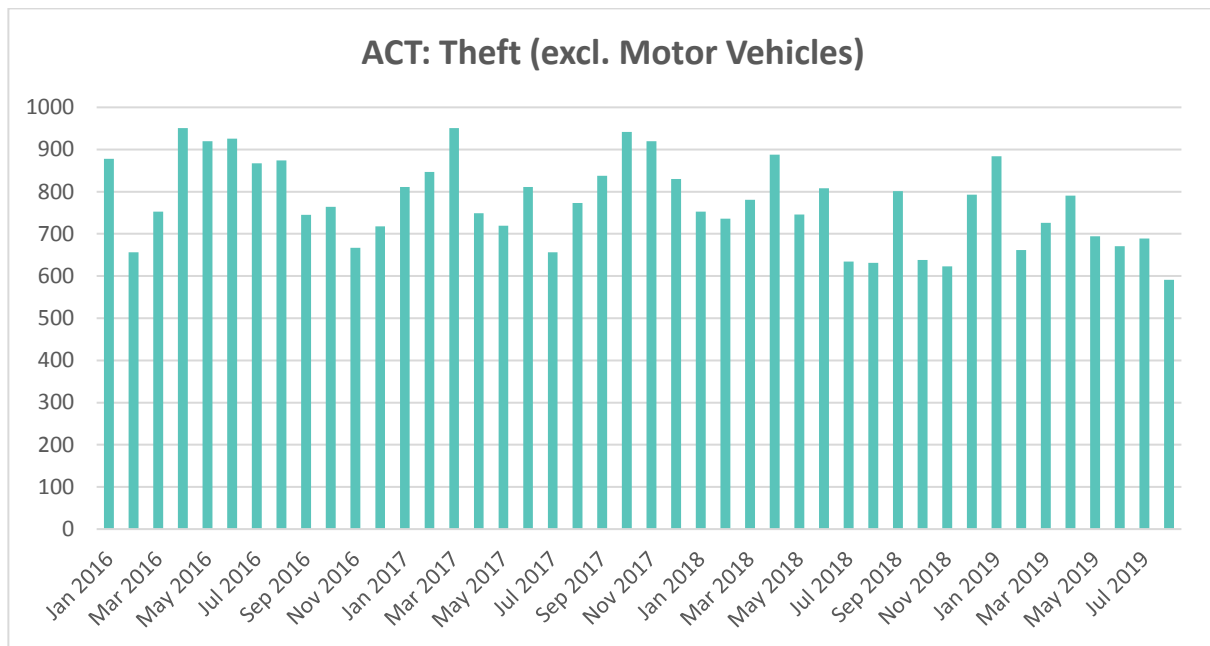


STATE AND TERRITORY RETAIL CRIME STATISTICS

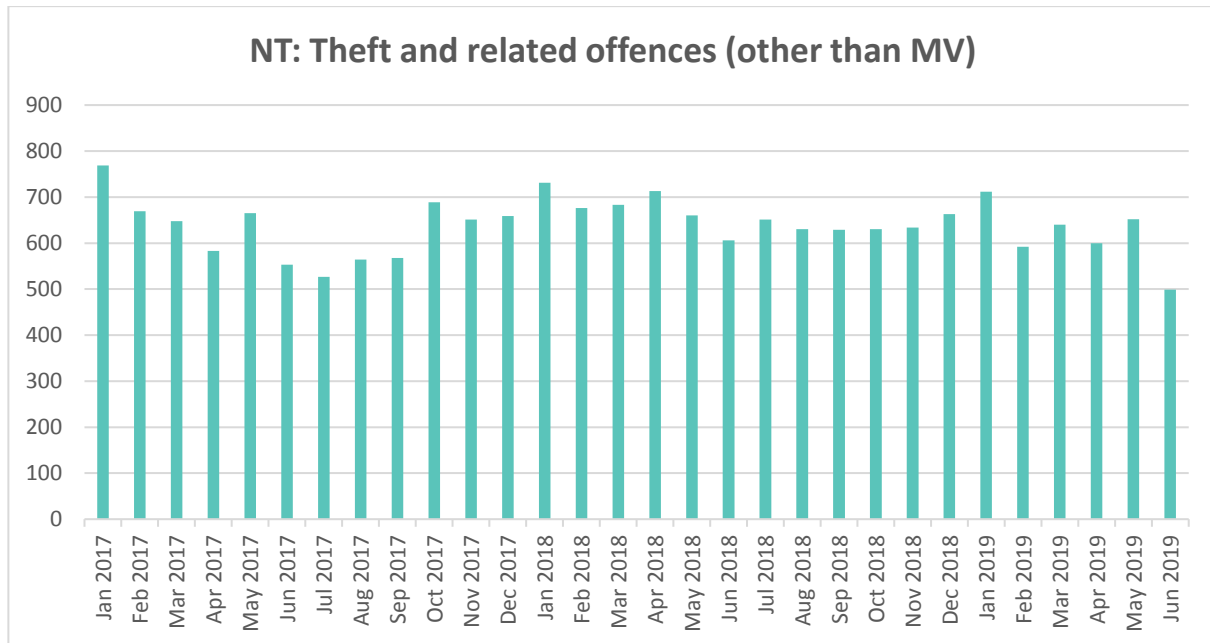
The National Retail Association will update this information as it becomes available.

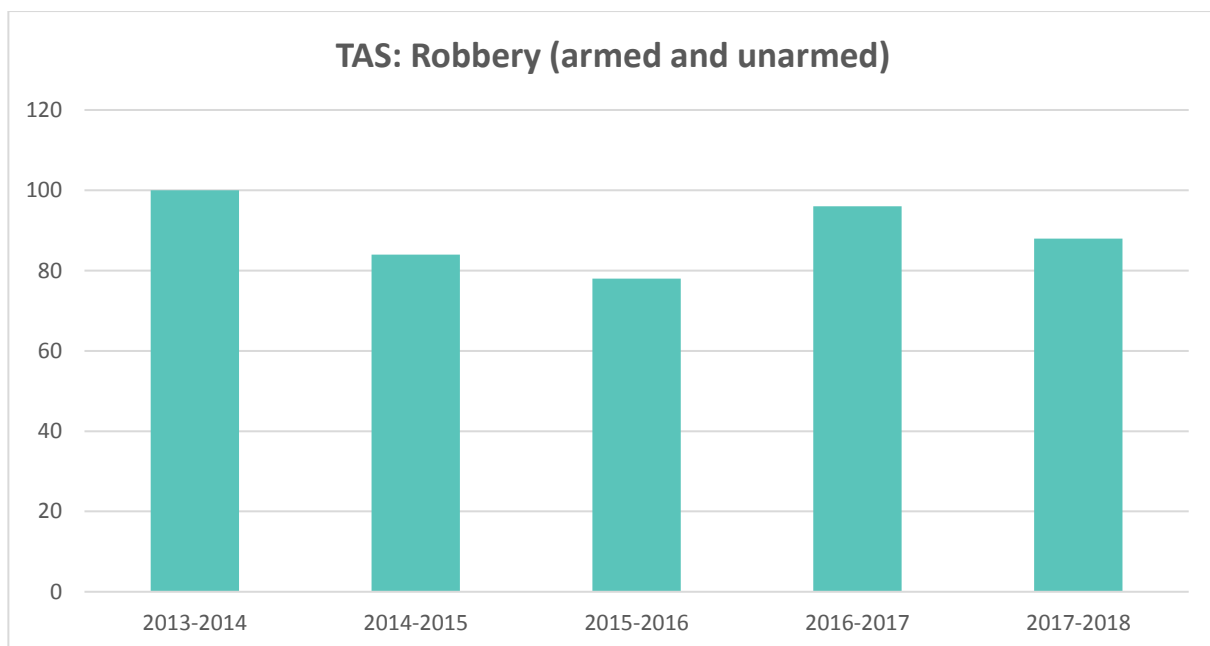
