WHAT TRAINING IS AVAILABLE?

RETAIL QUALIFICATIONS

At the completion of your traineeship and assessments you will be issued with either a Certificate II in Retail Services or Certificate III in Retail. These qualifications can be used to open the door to a Retail Career.
